Born on January 22, 1906, Stefanie and her husband, John Weill, immigrated to the U.S. in 1941 from Vienna, Austria. Upon arriving in Sheboygan, Mr. Weill assumed management of the American Chair Company and Stefanie became a member of Pine Hills Country Club, served on the Board of Directors of the John Michael Kohler Arts Center, and was active in Friends of Sheboygan Symphony and many other community and civic organizations.



The Stefanie H. Weill Charitable Fund was established in 1969, making several contributions within the community. The completion of the final renovations to the 'Sheboygan Theatre' were made possible by the Stefanie H. Weill Charitable Foundation, Inc. and therefore the newly restored theater was given the name Stefanie H. Weill Center for the Performing Arts.



The Charitable Fund also supported the Clock Tower and Weill/Byk Terrace at the Mead Public Library. The Library also holds the Stefanie H. Weill Collection.



Stefanie's ultimate mission was to preserve the historic theater and make it accessible for all ages to enjoy arts opportunities that entertain and inspire!
